In December 1992 Ms. Ferrer joined the office of Méndez Brunner, Badillo & Associates to reinforce the Design and Production Departments. She began her professional career in 1985 as an Architectural Designer working for other firms. She was involved in the design of private homes, office building, and public parks. In 1988, she joined the offices of Simon Drury Ltd. where she was in-charge of the interior planning department where she worked on the interior architecture of banks, insurance companies, commercial offices, medical laboratories, pharmacies, and hospitals.

After joining the office of Méndez, Brunner, Badillo & Associates working as an Architect, her job assignments involved residential design, and later on focused on the interior planning of over 40 different types of medical offices, Federal Government agencies and private sector client's commercial spaces. Ms. Ferrer, became an Associate of Méndez Brunner, Badillo & Associates in 2002 and as part of her responsibilities, she worked and still works very closely with engineer/principal Rafael G. Méndez, PE on Federal Government projects, for agencies such as Immigration Customs Enforcement (ICE), U. S. Marshalls, U.S. Bankruptcy Court, General Services Administration (GSA), Social Security Office of Disability Adjudication & Review, Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA), Veterans Affairs (VA), and Internal Revenue Service (IRS) many of these jobs are of a highly sensitive nature, reason why MBBA can not show/publish photos of the finished project.

Work at MBBA has focused for some years now on projects for the Veterans Affairs Caribbean Healthcare System, (VACHS) some of these are Design-Build projects done in collaboration with other Project Management firms. These projects include among other, the renovation of a 150+ chair auditorium, and of a largescale VA Emergency Medical Supplies Warehouse, the Expansion and Renovation of the Existing Emergency Department and Observation Unit, part of the team for a design-build project of a new, 3-mile long 38KV Powerline, the new Covid Testing Laboratory and the Hurricane Recovery Projects Phase I. Work on VACHS projects includes also the following two (2) ongoing projects: Provide Public Address System to all VA Hospital Buildings and Up-grade Synchronization Stand-by Power System both at the VA, San Juan, Hospital Compound.

Since the fall 2010, Ms. Ferrer is an adjunct professor at the PUCPR School of Architecture, and since 2015 she was appointed as the Coordinator of the Sustainable Technologies Academic Unit and is the Licensing Advisor for the NCARB, AXP Program at the PUCPR School of Architecture.
